- Birth Certificate or Record of Birth
(Certified copies of birth certificates available for purchase)
- Updated Tennessee Immunization Certificate or Immunization Record
(You can also receive a copy at the fair)
- Proof of Physical
- Proof of Davidson County residency
- Parent/Guardian photo ID

If you plan to attend the fair and have three or more children who will be enrolling or receiving immunizations, please email the MNPS Early Learning Department for more information at EarlyLearningPreK@mnps.org.

Eligible children from birth through 18 years of age may receive free, federally-funded vaccine through the Vaccines for Children Program (VFC). Children from birth through 18 years of age must meet at least one of the following criteria are eligible to receive VFC vaccine: TennCare, Uninsured, American Indian or Alaska Native or Underinsured.

An administration fee of \$20 is charged for vaccines but will slide according to income. If you have private insurance, private stock vaccine is available. Money is collected at time of visit by cash, check, or credit card. Metro Health Department can bill CoverKids but we do not bill private insurance at this time. However, we will provide a patient services ledger if you wish to seek reimbursement. COVID vaccines will be available to individuals 6 months of age and older free of charge. If you have received previous COVID vaccines, please bring your vaccination card with you.
