

PRE-K CAN HELP PREPARE YOUR CHILD FOR SUCCESS IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND BEYOND. METRO SCHOOLS OFFERS MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR PRE-K THAN EVER BEFORE, AND THIS GUIDE WILL HELP YOU NAVIGATE THE DIFFERENT OPTIONS.

Once you have found the right option for your family, you will need to obtain an MNPS student identification number and then you can submit a Pre-K application online through the MNPS website.

The deadline for submitting applications is April 1, 2024, at 3:30 p.m. Applications received before the deadline will be included in a random selection process that determines placement based on program eligibilities. Applications received after the deadline will be added to the end of the waitlist.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR PRE-K PROGRAMS?

All Pre-K students must be age four on or before August 15, 2024, and a resident of Davidson County, with limited exceptions.

HOW MUCH DO PRE-K PROGRAMS COST?

Some Pre-K seats require a fee, which is based on a sliding scale. Depending on a family's household income and the number of family members in the household, that fee could be anywhere from \$0-\$144 per child every week. The fee does not include before or after care. For more information, visit the Pre-K Program Fees section (under Pre-Kindergarten) of the MNPS Early Learning website.

WHY ARE SOME SEATS FEE BASED AND SOME SEATS HAVE INCOME REQUIREMENTS?

Metro Pre-K classrooms are funded in a number of different ways, including using local and state funding. Each fund source has different requirements, like serving families based on income within Davidson County or charging a fee.

WHY DO I HAVE TO SUBMIT INCOME INFORMATION TO APPLY?

Income information is used to determine if the child is eligible to enroll in a fee based seat or an income required seat.

WHAT ARE THE EARLY LEARNING CENTERS? ARE THEY DIFFERENT FROM THE OTHER PRE-K PROGRAMS?

MNPS has four Early Learning Centers (ELC): Cambridge ELC, Casa Azafrán ELC, Ivanetta H. Davis ELC and Ross ELC. These are schools that exclusively serve Pre-K students. The curriculum used at these centers will be the same as the majority of MNPS Pre-K programs.

WHAT IS A BLENDED CLASSROOM?

Blended Pre-K classes are designed for students with and without disabilities. Class sizes are typically smaller and seats are limited within blended programs.

DOES MNPS HAVE A HALF-DAY PROGRAM?

MNPS has a half-day program for children who are three years of age by or on August 15, 2024. The program is located at Ross Early Learning Center and offers families a morning or afternoon session. Families can apply for the program through the MNPS Pre-K application process.

HOW LONG DOES A STUDENT REMAIN ON THE WAIT LIST?

The wait list will remain active throughout the school year. As vacancies occur, families will be contacted about an acceptance into a Pre-K program vacancy.

IS THERE A SIBLING OR EMPLOYEE PREFERENCE TO ATTEND A PRE-K PROGRAM IN A CERTAIN SCHOOL?

Yes, there are sibling, employee and zone preferences applied for families who meet the program eligibility.

IS TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED?

Metro Schools does not provide school bus transportation for Pre-K. Parents are responsible for bringing and picking up their child, unless outlined in the child's Individualized Education Program for students with disabilities.

CAN I APPLY FOR HEAD START THROUGH THIS PROCESS?

Head Start programs are not provided by MNPS and a separate program. Families will need to contact Head Start for enrollment information at 615-862-8860.

HOW DO I KNOW IF THE SCHOOL HAS A BEFORE AND AFTER CARE PROGRAM?

SOME PRE-K SEATS AT SCHOOL SITES HAVE FEES OR INCOME REQUIREMENTS AND OTHERS DO NOT. Fees are charged on a sliding scale and could range from \$0-\$144 per week for each child, depending on household income. This fee does not include extended care fees.
